Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation Summer Intern Program

Please read this information before completing the application on the reverse side.

THE PROGRAM

Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation's Summer Intern Program was created to provide opportunities for college students to gain firsthand knowledge and understanding of the programs and services of Farm Bureau as well as the many issues facing Mississippi farmers and ranchers.

The Intern Program offers an internship to students in any major dealing with agriculture.

There is one summer internship that is six-weeks in length.

DURATION

Internships typically run during the summer months; however, it may be possible for other arrangements to be made:

Exact starting and ending dates will be arranged between the intern and the supervisor.

All internships are full-time unless otherwise indicated on the position announcement.

COLLEGE CREDIT

Many schools offer academic credit for internships. To determine if your school offers credit and/or the requirements of obtaining credit, you must contact your school's career placement office or your academic advisor.

PREFERENCE

Preference will be given to those students who are residents of Mississippi or who are attending an institution of higher learning within Mississippi; however, any student meeting the eligibility criteria may apply.

SELECTION

Selected applicant will be notified by March 19, 2012.

ELIGIBILITY

Any full-time student who is currently enrolled at an institution of higher education in a field of agriculture is eligible to apply to the Intern Program.

If you attend a college, university or community college, you must be carrying at least 12 credit hours and have junior standing or above in a field of agriculture for the 2012-2013 school year.

COMPENSATION

All internships are paid. The hourly wage is indicated on the position announcement.

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

**Students applying for the internship must complete an application for the position. ** It is permissible to submit a photocopy of the application as long as the following criteria are met:

- **Each application must include a resume.** Applicants will be asked to submit resumes before applications are evaluated.
- **Each application must include a 500 -750 word essay relating the applicant's agriculture background, the plans the applicant has for a career in agriculture, and how the applicant thinks their experience as an intern will help them with their career in agriculture.**
- **Applications must be postmarked or emailed no later than February 15, 2012, to be accepted.** The application deadline is indicated on each position announcement.

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
